## ORGANIZATIONAL PREMISE

It is the joint purpose of the Wetaskiwin Airshow to display a cross-section of General Aviation Aircraft for the interest of public visiting the Wetaskiwin Airshow. Displays from the following categories will be solicited: Antique, Classic, Warbird, Aerobatic, Float, Homebuilt, Ultralight and others. In order to give our public a broad overview of aviation, it is proposed that there be no duplication of models and confirmation will be on a first come first serve basis.

## PROVISIONS FOR PARTICIPANTS

- 2 one-day individual admission badges per aircraft per day
- 2 one-day VIP passes per aircraft per day
- 2008 Participant Recognition Item

## DISPLAY DETAILS

The Wetaskiwin Airshow will give priority to those aircraft owners who can commit an aircraft for static display for the entire two days of the event (arriving prior to 1800h on Friday, July 25th, and departing after the flying events on Sunday, July 27th).

Any display aircraft which are not available for the entire weekend must be on-site prior to 0930h on the morning of their arrival.

Aircraft on display will be supplied with:

- Ropes and stanchions for crowd control around the aircraft
- Chocks
- Tie Downs (if necessary)
- Airshow security is on-site 24hrs/day, and the site is secured with a fenced perimeter. This will be 'area' security and will not be for each aircraft.
